Children attending various Vacation Bible Schools and Youth Camps in the U.S. gave offerings to help support Rivers of Mercy Children's Home in Mexico City. Rivas for immediate use. During the summer the children at Rivers of Mercy have sponsored and operated an outreach ministry to kids in their community. The older children taught the children the Gospel and introduced them to the Bible. They averaged 70 children in attendance. This is a wonderful relationship: Christian children helping provide a home and the gospel to children in another country, who then take the gospel to children in their surrounding area. Most of the children who were ministered to were from poor families and have had a very difficult life. So the children not only provided the Gospel, but also food and skits geared to bring a little joy to an otherwise difficult life. This is Christianity in action...God is working and doing amazing things through this ministry.
